- 1. Register for the courses according to your study plan
- 2. Pass the comprehensive exam (Plan B) (date and time are determined by the program)
- Request the appointment of the minor thesis examination committee and the minor thesis examination date (set by the faculty)
- 4. Submit the completed minor thesis
- 5. Submit a request for completion of study online at https://reg.psu.ac.th/isr/index.aspx
